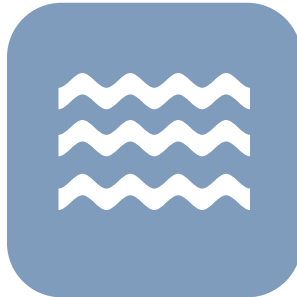

# Adriatic Model of Sustainable Mobility in Health & Care Sector

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<b>General and specific objectives of the activity</b>	<p>The general objective of the activity is to elaborate joint procedures and cross-border protocols for a sustainable transport strategy. This activity is conceived as guideline for the definition of policies, tools, networks, models, actors and resources for the adoption of a sustainable transport model in the health and care sector.</p> <p>The specific objectives of the activity are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● define procedures and strategies able to ensure the collection of data with regard to patient mobility, service mobility and professional mobility.</li> <li>● draft paths and processes for the recognition of diploma for professional;</li> <li>● outline accreditation requirements for health institutions and other tools capable to assure an high quality level of health and care assistance;</li> <li>● develop a network of cross-border health and care providers in the Adriatic area connected through effective transport services, infrastructures and models;</li> <li>● introduce practices of joint planning of health, transport and infrastructures.</li> </ul>

**Description of the activity**

In a first moment, under the coordination of the Agency for Accreditation of Health Care Institutions of Serbia, the Ministries of Health, together with the Ministries of Transport, propose models and methodologies for the collection, analysis and sharing of data about cross-border health and care and transport needs.

Following, the Ministries of Health, in collaboration with the universities and the ICT partners, propose models and methodologies for the implementation of a common cross-border system of training for health and care staff.

In a second moment, the Ministries of Health and health related partners discuss, share and define the standards and requirements for the accreditation system. These partners also provide the scheme for the establishment of an Adriatic Health and Care Insurance Card.

Subsequently, Ministries of Health and health related partners develop a proposal of statute and regulations for the constitution of an Adriatic Health and Care Mobility Association, the government body of the AdriHealthMob cross-border health and care network.

In the final phase, the Ministries of Health and health related partners work with the Ministry of Transport of Bosnia and Herzegovina on the advancement of a common model of planning, introducing the transport planning in the health and care development and, on the contrary, bringing the health and care needs in the decision round-tables of transport and infrastructures.

**Expected results**

The expected results of this activity are to:

- define protocols for the collection, the analysis, the assessment and the reporting of key data;
- develop protocols and memorandum of understanding about recognition of diploma, acknowledgment of credits, coding and joint training;
- provide health and care professional the access to training opportunities;
- delineate a register of health institutions able to provide high quality assistance;
- introduce a kind of Adriatic Health and Care Insurance Card;
- realise an Adriatic Health and Care Mobility Association for joint planning, provision and implementation of integrated transport, health and care;
- introduce the Joint Health and Transport Planning.
