Description of the activity	In a first moment, will be carried forward an investigation about the existing experiences with reference to the transport services for the Health and Care sector. More specifically, the research will be realized under the coordination of the Polytechnic University of Marche. The WP Leader, in strict collaboration with the whole partnership, designs a tool for the collection of information, also able to assure the comparability of data. The partnership identifies the best practices in their local context, also involving the networks they are members. In a second moment, the Polytechnic University of Marche collects the interventions identified (300) and realises a tailored analysis on relevant aspects and dimensions. The aim of this assessment is to identify the most innovative and effective projects. Hence, the partners, on the basis of their role within AdriHealthMob, will have the task and the opportunity to develop networks and with the best practices identified. More specifically, the partners most strictly involved in this phase (Business and Economy Promotion Center, Innopolis, Ionian University, Tetras, MSC, COOSS Marche) will organise and realize clustering events, as opportunity to disseminate the project and to valorise the synergies with the selected best and innovative practices.
